



## INSTRUCTIONS:

Lace and Trace a Peep: Print the page on a thick cardstock. Cut the shape out, then use a standard size hold punch to create a guide all the way along the image. Measure twine or yarn to be twice the length of the image radius (~50 inches). Tie one end to the top of the ear and have your child lace thru the holes all the way around. This is the perfect Easter activity for your young children. This will help develop hand-eye coordination, fine motor skills, cognitive skills and visual perception skills.

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
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
